About the workshop.

The demise of influence and participation in Christianity and church life within our culture is well-documented as are its perceived and proven idiosyncrasies, foibles and moral failures. Far fewer words have been written about what people might continue to value in Christian spirituality and the shape, colour, fabric and texture of their hopes and dreaming for its current and future expressions.

This is a verbal and visual overview of the findings from the large collection of stories captured in an extended Appreciative Inquiry research project. What emerges is a clear sense of the longing and need for a robust spirituality of the everyday that expresses itself primarily in the quest for a more compassionate, just and courageous way of being. The findings are not an end in themselves but rather an invitation for those participating in the workshop to join the process of reimagining authentic Christian spirituality for yourself and others.
